Mt. Oyama is a holy mountain in Isehara City, Kanagawa prefecture. It has been an object of faith and a place of teaching throughout history, and was worshipped by people of all walks of life. Minamoto no Yoritomo offered a sword to defeat the Taira clan, and it is said that from this the culture of "Osamedachi" (sword offering) was born, and its influence can even be seen in Japanese Rakugo comedy and Ukiyo-e art. The surrounding area is full of delights, such as the seasonal natural surroundings, the historic Oyama Afuri Shrine, the stunning views from the mountain cable car, and places to sample the local cuisine.
